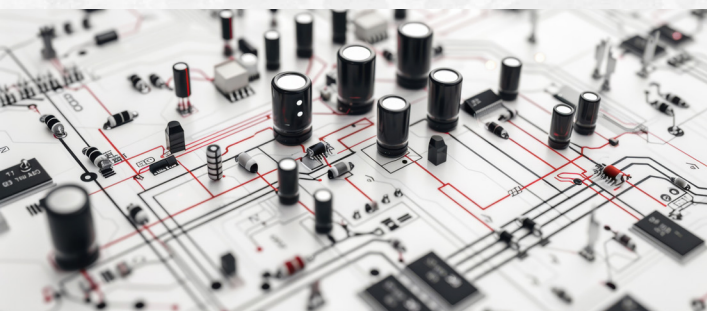


## About NCET
